HISTORY:

MOROCCO HAS AN ANCIENT AND RICH CIVILIZATION AND CULTURE. MOROCCO'S DISTINCT CULTURE IS A BLEND OF MANY INFLUENCES, INCLUDING INDIGENOUS MOROCCO'S OFFICIAL LANGUAGES ARE BERBER AND ARABIC. BERBER, SUB-SAHARAN AFRICAN, ARAB, AND EUROPEAN INFLUENCES. THE STATE OF MOROCCO IS ABOUT THE SAME SIZE AS CALIFORNIA. THE KINGDOM OF MOROCCO IS THE MOST WESTERN OF THE NORTH. THE KINGDOM HAS AN AREA OF 710,850 SQUARE KILOMETERS (274,460 SQUARE MILES)
