



Year One Reading Routines

Read, Write, Inc. Session Books

During your child's daily taught sessions in school, they will be reading a Read, Write, Inc. book at an instructional level. Once they have read this book 3 times in school, they will bring it home to read. We will record in Reading Diaries when the book is due for return which normally ties in with the next RWI book being sent home.

Book Banded Books

A new book banded book will be distributed every **Monday**. These books are pitched at an "easy level" to encourage a positive experience and fluent reading. Their book banded book will be the colour band below the Read, Write, Inc. level they are working on in school. Don't forget, we encourage a book to be read 3 times throughout the week; once for decoding, twice for comprehension and thirdly for fluency. We will only change this book if it has been read at home. This will be measured through your written comments in your child's reading diary.

Library Books

Class 1 visit the library every **Friday** afternoon. The children will choose a new library book every week to share with you at home. We will collect these books back in to change every Friday

Early reading is one of the most vital skills we teach in Class One. It is proven that children that read regularly at home, do well in school. Please try to read with your child as often as you possibly can. It really does make such a difference to their confidence and progress. We recommend that any school books are stored and kept in book bags in order to ensure their safe and prompt return.
