PE & Forest School

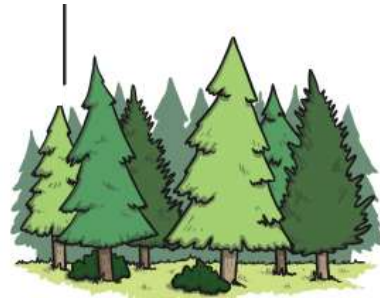
PE days are Wednesdays and Thursdays still, our last Forest School of this term is

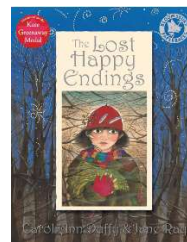
Topics and Themes

Our topic this half term is

Forests and Woodlands



Our key text is:



Our main topic this term is 'Forests and Woodlands' which we will learn about in our Geography lessons. Our question is 'Why is our world wonderful?' We'll also be looking at other habitats and exploring the physical and human features of other parts of the world.

In English we'll be reading 'The Lost Happy Endings' by Carol Anne Duffy. This week we found out that the Happy Endings have been stolen and we've been using our investigative skills to help find out who did it.

In Maths we have moved on to our addition and subtraction unit, then we will move onto multiplication and division.

In Science we are learning about plants and what they need to stay healthy.

In RE our inquiry question is: 'What does it mean to be called by God?' and 'How does the presence of Jesus impact on peoples' lives?'

In Design and Technology, we are looking at cooking seasonal food. On Friday 8th November we will forage for our own seasonal fruit and make their own individual apple crumble to take home and cook.

In Music, we will be creating compositions in response to an animation.
