


Topics and Themes

This half term we are still looking at our topic 'Settlements' With our enquiry question being 'are all settlements the same?' Through this Geography topic we will be looking at land use in our local area and comparing it with that land use in New Delhi, India.

In maths, we are continuing with our multiplication and division unit. We'll also be looking at money and measurement.

In RE, the question we will be answering is 'how do symbols help us understand the Easter story?

Our Science topic this term is Plants. We'll be learning about what seeds and bulbs need to grow, and we'll be growing our own sweet peas and testing how light affects plant growth.

In Design and Technology, we will be designing and evaluating our own wearable digital technology.

Computing this term is all about databases.
