Aquarium Trip **Thursday 10th July** – more details to follow.

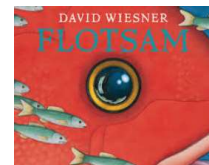
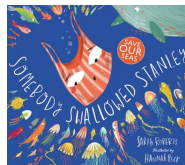
Reading at home

Children will bring home with them their reading book and reading record every day. They are encouraged to read at home with an adult every day, with any RWI books read three times to support fluency. Any other colour banded books are to be read once before they can be changed.

Our topic this half term is...



Our key texts are:



This half term we will be learning about our Blue Planet! In Geography our enquiry question is 'What is it like to live by the coast?' We will be looking at the oceans and seas that surround the UK and use a compass to explain their location.

In Maths, we are continuing with our work on Fractions, before moving on to Time.

In RE our question is: why is the church a special place for Christians? We will also spend time looking at holy building of other faiths, including Hinduism, Islam and Judaism.

In Science we are learning what animals' need for survival where we will recap what mammals, birds, reptiles, fish and amphibians are and learn about what they need to survive. We will also spend some time looking at sustainability – with plastic in particular and how it can be harmful to



In Music we will be looking at traditional instruments from India and learn to play instruments and sing in time. In art, our unit is called 'Map it Out' and we'll explore and create maps through different art forms.

In PSHE, our unit is called Growing and Changing and we'll look at different relationships and what is meant by personal space.

In computing we'll be looking at media.
